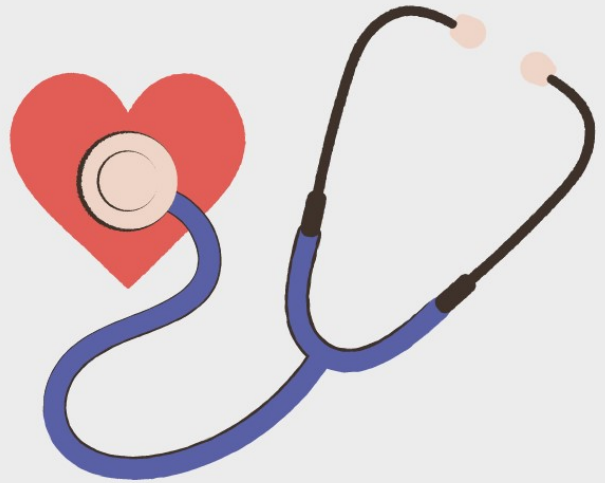

- MRI of the Abdomen

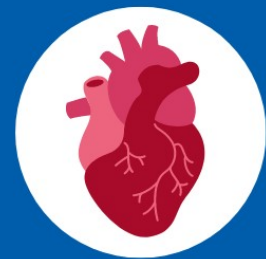
## BENEFITS OF STUDY PARTICIPATION
